Taking the official language of the MHC website as a starting point, certain girls... draws from a wide range of texts and phenomena exploring identity and community. The languages of anonymous web posts, personal narratives, marketing material, and more all co-exist on a shifting landscape of secrets, longings, histories, and memories. Inspired by the experimental approaches of theater, dance, and performance art, the ensemble creates a theatrical terrain where the embodied and virtual intersect.

"Among all these sites, I am interested in certain ones that have the curious property of being in relation with all the other sites, but in such a way as to suspect, neutralize, or invent the set of relations that they happen to designate, mirror, or reflect. ... These countersites [are] a kind of enacted utopia in which all the other real sites are simultaneously represented, contested, and inverted. ... Thus it is that the theater brings onto the rectangle of the stage, one after the other, a whole series of places that are foreign to one another... [and] a system of opening and closing that both isolates them and makes them penetrable."

Information (Director's Notes)

In Lectures in America, poet, novelist, and playwright Gertrude Stein posits a new theory of dramatic form and content. In lieu of accepted principles of character and plot, she offers a structure founded on the idea of "landscape." Of her opus Four Saints in Three Acts, Stein observes: "a landscape does not move nothing really moves in a landscape but things are there, and I put into the play the things that were there."

Relying on repetition, juxtaposition, and simultaneity, certain girls... creates a space for "the things that were there" to co-exist. Those "things" are the ensemble's own memories, imaginations, and fascinations—reflected, remembered, and replicated in the sounds, texts, and images of the performance. This theatrical landscape is necessarily anxious and unreconciled, as the dynamics of identity and community often are. Who are we? What is this place? Who do we become when we are in this place?

As Stein reminds us, "All these things might have been a story, but as a landscape they were just there and a play is just there."
